Enhancing Access to LGBTQ+ Fiction: Subject Access and Search Interfaces in the QueerLit Project

The QueerLit project aims to advance the discoverability and accessibility of LGBTQ+ fiction through innovative approaches to subject access and search interface design. This presentation explores the challenges of indexing and retrieving materials related to LGBTQ+ themes and identities in library and information systems. Key highlights include the development of inclusive metadata practices, and user-centered search interfaces that make use of the subject metadata. Attendees will gain insights into how the QueerLit project addresses barriers to equitable access while fostering a richer, more inclusive literary landscape.
